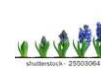
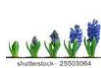

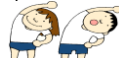
HAPPY BIRTHDAY

Wanted - rolls of unwanted wallpaper to put on the floor for mark making using gross motor movements.



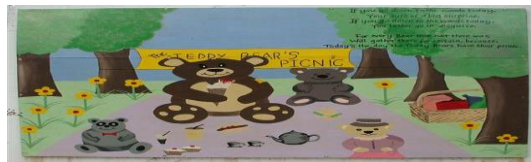
Dates for diary -
